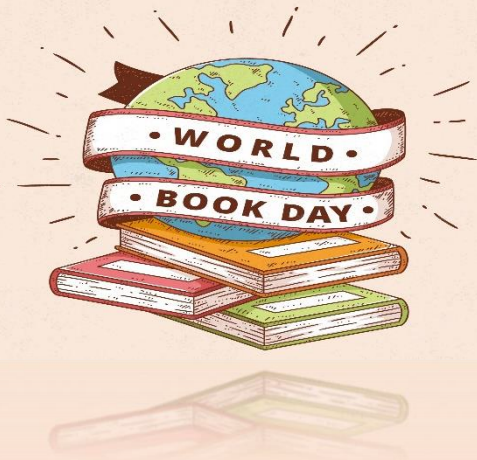

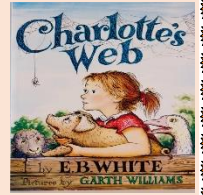

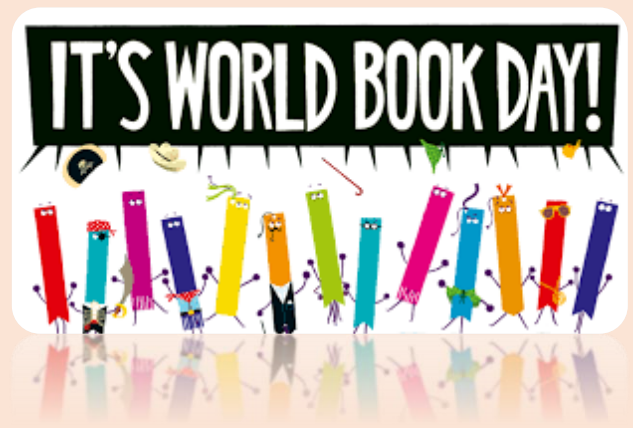
power of books and the joy of reading. It's especially meant to help encourage a love of reading in children, but people of all ages can recognize and celebrate the day.
